Our train will leave Denver's Union Station at 9:00 a.m. for a 2 ½ hour ride through the Rockies, dropping participants off directly at the base of the Winter Park Resort. You'll enjoy an outdoor BBQ at the base of the mountain from 12:00-1:30 pm leaving an afternoon open to mountain bike, hike, play miniature golf, ride the Alpine Slide and sightsee at the resort. The train will head back to Denver at 4:00 p.m. where you can enjoy not only the scenic wonders of the Flatirons and South Boulder Canyon but also encounter rugged alpine wilderness and vistas not seen anywhere else but on the Train. Gordon Memorial Award Dinner – Tuesday, June 26

When you pick up your on-site registration materials in Denver, you will be given a voucher for the Gordon Memorial Award Dinner. Vouchers **must** be exchanged for tickets by **Monday, June 25 at 10:00 a.m.** If you do not exchange your voucher for a ticket by that time, we cannot guarantee that there will be a meal for you. Tickets will be issued for assigned tables. If you wish to set up a full table for 10, you will need to exchange your vouchers as a group, or have one person collect your group's 10 vouchers and exchange them for tickets at the same table. You may wish to do this during your regional meetings on Sunday. **Admission to the Gordon Memorial Award Dinner will be by ticket only.**

When you exchange your voucher, please indicate if you have **any food allergies, such as shellfish, nuts and dairy products.** Special meal requirements reflect special needs and *not* personal preferences. Special meal requirements must be confirmed on-site when you select your table. **We can accommodate those with food allergies or religious dietary requirements, and there is always a vegetarian option available if requested *in advance*.** We are not able to handle requests for low-carb meals, or to have the meat cooked to your specific preference, nor can you request an entirely different entrée. The hotel staff will not be able to handle special requests made at the dinner. If you have a special dietary requirement, please let us know in advance and reconfirm when you make your seat selection.
