

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

Next Capitol Conference Registration deadline: Friday, January 4th

This means:

- Faxed registrations (with payment in full via credit card) must be received at NAHU no later than midnight eastern time on January 4th.
- Electronic registrations (with payment in full via credit card) must be e-mailed no later than midnight eastern time on January 4th.
- Mailed registrations must be postmarked no later than January 4th.
- Registrations using NAHU bucks or with payment by check must be mailed!

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Capitol Conference is returning to the JW Marriott Hotel! Located at 1331 Pennsylvania Avenue, the JW Marriott is located amongst the most recognizable landmarks of Washington, DC, providing easy access to DC's renowned monuments, museums and cultural venues. Access to the Metro system (red, blue and orange lines) is a block away.

The hotel completed a multi-million dollar renovation in 2007, and all guest rooms now feature 300-thread-count

sheets, fluffier pillows, thicker mattresses, and down comforters. Guest rooms have 32-inch HD TVs with connections for your MP3 player and video camera. In addition to a coffee maker and spa robe, each room has a full-sized safe that can accommodate a laptop. Access to the hotel's fitness center and indoor pool is complimentary. In-room high-speed internet access is available for a charge of \$9.95/24 hours. Check-in time is 4:00 p.m.; check-out time is noon.

Non-Smoking Hotel

As you may have heard, Marriott International announced that all of the company's lodging brands in the United States and Canada are 100% smoke-free. The new policy includes all guest rooms, restaurants, lounges, meeting rooms, public space and employee work areas. To accommodate the needs of guests who smoke, the hotel will offer special designated smoking areas outside the building. **You will not be permitted to smoke in your guest room at the JW Marriott.**

Be sure to identify yourself as a NAHU Capitol Conference attendee to obtain the discounted rate of \$262+ tax for single or double occupancy. You also may book online by visiting the hotel reservation page at www.marriott.com/property/propertypage/wasjw. Enter your arrival and departure dates, and enter NAHNAHA as the Group Code. (This code is for single or double occupancy only.)

Please remember that the hotel is only obligated to honor our conference rate until we fill our contracted block of rooms, and they are not required to give you our conference rate if you call after January 4th, even if they have rooms available.
